

Information about the creation, processing and publication of images/sound recordings/video recordings by DLR

The Deutsches Zentrum für Luft- und Raumfahrt e.V. (DLR), the German Aerospace Center, is organising the event at hand. We take the protection of your personal data very seriously.

DLR is subject to the provisions of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the German Federal Data Protection Act (Bundesdatenschutzgesetz (BDSG)) and, where applicable, other relevant data protection statute laws. We have taken technical and organisational measures to ensure that these data protection regulations are complied with.

This information about data protection concerns two areas:

The recording and processing of images/sound recordings/video recordings during this event – and their subsequent publication.

1. Processing of images/sound recordings/video recordings of you

During the event, DLR 's own staff or photographers/camera crews commissioned by DLR will produce images/sound recordings/video recordings featuring individuals over the age of 16 for documentation purposes. The images and recordings in question will be stored for up to 70 years after the death of the creator/author in order to defend their copyrights.

Should you not wish to be photographed or filmed, please inform the photographer/camera crew. They will respect your request.

The legal basis for the processing of personal data associated with the production of photographs and other recordings is contained in Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR: DLR has a legitimate interest in the documentation of the event. DLR has taken the interests, fundamental freedoms and rights of the data subjects into account by giving them the opportunity to inform the photographer/camera crew if they do not wish to be included in the recordings.

Minors under the age of 16 years will not participate in the event.

Your personal data protection rights according to the GDPR are explained in the attached document.

2. Publication of images/sound recordings/video recordings

Unless you have objected to being included in the images/sound recordings/video recordings, we will assume that you have consented to the publication of the recordings, in the sense that DLR is entitled to publish the photographs and recordings taken at the above-mentioned event for public relations and journalistic purposes, for illustration purposes, and for commercial purposes.

In addition, you hereby grant DLR a non-exclusive right of use for the aforementioned images/sound recordings/video recordings for all types of use (including those that are currently unknown) and in all forms of electronic and other media. In particular, DLR may publish the recordings without geographical restriction in an unaltered form, using any type of transmission, carrier and storage (in particular by means of electronic image processing), in all types of media for illustration, publicity, acquisition and advertising purposes, including for commercial purposes.

You hereby also grant DLR the right to distribute the images/sound recordings/video recordings, for editorial purposes only, to the following entities:

- Regional
 - radio and television stations
 - daily newspapers
 - including their respective online presence
- Supra-regional with headquarters in the Federal Republic of Germany
 - radio and television stations
 - daily newspapers
 - news agencies
 - including their respective online presence

as well as

- for the Internet presentation of the German Aerospace Center (DLR)

in a documented format.

You should be aware that different storage periods may apply for press and media archives (online and offline) at the aforementioned offices.

The consent and granting of rights arising from this declaration are free of charge. You are not entitled to claim remuneration of any kind.

Information about your rights in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the German Federal Data Protection Act (BDSG) regarding the processing of images/sound recordings/video recordings

1. Purpose of the data processing

The images/sound recordings/video recordings will be processed for the purpose of publishing them as mentioned in this **Information about data protection in relation to images/sound recordings/video recordings in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation.**

The data needs to be stored for a period of time to ensure that the creator/originator of the images/sound recordings/video recordings can defend the copyrights to which they are entitled. As these rights will exist for 70 years after their death, the necessary storage period is 70 years after the death of the originator (for example, the photographer). Please note that you will not be able to revoke your consent to processing until after this date. The data cannot be erased prior to this date.

2. Duration of storage

The data will be deleted as soon as they are no longer required for the purpose for which they were collected. Data related to image/sound recording/video recording are stored until 70 years after the death of the creator.

3. Who is responsible for data processing and whom can I contact?

The responsible person – as defined by the General Data Protection Regulation, other national data protection laws of the member states and related data protection regulations – is:

Note:

Some employees of our IT service provider also have access to the image/sound recording/video recording data as part of the administration of our IT systems. If the data are deleted from DLR's systems, our IT service provider will no longer have access.

DLR has concluded a contract for commissioned data processing with the respective IT service provider in accordance with the statutory regulations to ensure that the IT service provider also complies with the requirements of data protection law and data security. We monitor compliance with these requirements as stipulated.

4. We process your data on the basis of Art. 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR

In accordance with Art. 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR, we process your image/sound recording/video recording data to protect our legitimate interests, to inform the public about the event, to document the event and to defend the copyrights for the duration of the image/sound recording/video recording copyright protection. The storage of this data is necessary in order to defend the copyright interests of the creator/originator of the image/sound recording/video recording up to 70 years after their death.

5. Is the data transmitted to any third countries?

The data are published on the Internet and used for other journalistic purposes.

6. Your rights as a data subject in relation to your personal data

According to the GDPR, a **data subject** is any person whose **personal data** is being collected, held or processed. They have the following rights in relation to the controller in accordance with the provisions specified below:

- (1) Pursuant to **Art. 15 of the GDPR**, you may request **information** about the personal data processed by us. In particular, you may request information about the purposes of the processing, the category of the personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your personal information has been or will be disclosed, the intended storage period and the existence of the rights explained in sections 4 and 6 of this document.
- (2) Pursuant to **Art. 16 GDPR**, you may request the immediate **rectification** of incorrect personal data or the completion of incomplete personal data stored by us.
- (3) Pursuant to **Art. 17 GDPR**, you may request the **erasure** of your personal data stored by us, unless the processing is necessary for legal reasons, in particular to exercise the right to freedom of expression and information, to comply with a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest, or for the establishment, exercise or potential defense of legal claims.
- (4) Pursuant to **Art. 18 GDPR**, you shall have the right to obtain from the controller **restriction of processing** if you contest the accuracy of these data, that the processing is unlawful and you have opposed the erasure of the personal data but requested the restriction of the use, we no longer require the data, but you need the data for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims or if you have filed an objection to the data processing in accordance with Art. 21 of the GDPR.
- (5) Pursuant to **Art. 20 GDPR**, you have the right to receive the personal data provided to the controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to **transmit** those data to another controller.
- (6) Pursuant to **Art. 7 (3) GDPR**, you shall have the right to withdraw the consent you previously granted to us at any time. As a result, we will no longer be permitted to continue the data processing that was based on this consent.
- (7) Pursuant to **Art. 21 of the GDPR – Right to object**

If your personal data is processed on the basis of legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR, you have the right to object to the processing of that personal data in accordance with Art. 21 of the GDPR, provided that there are reasons for this related to your particular situation or if the objection is directed against direct marketing. In the latter case, you have a general right of objection, which will be implemented by us without specifying any particular situation, unless the processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out for reasons of public interest. (as per Art. 21 (6) of the GDPR).

- (8) Pursuant to **Art. 77 GDPR**, you have the right to **lodge a complaint** with a supervisory authority. In general, the supervisory authority located at your habitual residence, place of work or the registered address of the controller is available for this purpose.
